SUN LINK CELEBRATES THIRD ANNIVERSARY

Celebrate with free rides and concert on streetcar

TUCSON, Ariz. – Sun Link will celebrate its third anniversary on Saturday, July 22. Tucson Electric Power and HealthOn Broadway will sponsor free rides on Sun Link from 8 a.m. on Saturday, July 22 to 2 a.m. on Sunday, July 23. KXCI and Main Gate Square will sponsor a free concert with Jimmy Carr and The Awkward Moments, performing on board at 6 p.m. For the concert, board at the stop on Avenida del Convento and Congress (across from Mercado San Agustin) and travel to Main Gate Square for more concerts and festivities.

Check Sun Link's Twitter and Facebook pages to identify the streetcar number that will host the performance. The location of the streetcar with the concert can also be found using the Tucson Streetcar Tracker app, which can be downloaded on Google Play and the Apple App Store.

Sun Tran has regularly scheduled service along the streetcar line, providing a convenient and cost-effective travel option to this event. Please consult the Ride Guide for best route and times. For trip planning assistance call customer service or visit suntran.com.

The Sun Link streetcar project, which was funded through the Regional Transportation Authority's \$2.1 billion, 20-year RTA plan and federal dollars, was co-managed by the City of Tucson and the RTA through construction and service launch. The RTA and the City continue to provide annual operations' funding of the streetcar system. The RTA plan will be implemented through 2026. More than halfway through implementation, the multimodal plan includes roadway, safety, transit, environmental and economic vitality improvements. Since its launch on July 25, 2014, the Sun Link streetcar has provided approximately 2.93 million rides to passengers.
