AJO DIAL-A-RIDE

The Ajo Dial-a-Ride service covers the community within a six-mile radius of the Ajo Plaza. This convenient service will transport you to shopping, social centers, churches, or to visit friends in accessible vans.

This service operates six days a week, Monday through Saturday, from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. on a demand responsive "first come, first served" basis.

One-Way Fare: 75¢

AJO-TUCSON SERVICE

The Ajo-Tucson route provides accessible transportation from Ajo to Tucson and to points in between. Approximately 130 miles in length, it serves Ajo and Why on State Route 85, traverses the Tohono O'odham Nation on State Route 86, continues to Robles Junction (Three Points) and on into Tucson to the Laos Transit Center. Here riders can transfer to Sun Tran.

For an additional fee, Ajo Transportation Company will provide transportation to other locations in Tucson. Please contact the Ajo Transportation Company for details.

Holiday Schedule: There is no service on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
