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## **SUN TRAN ANNOUNCES FALL SCHEDULE CHANGES**

### *Adds More RTA Funded Improvements*

TUCSON, Ariz. – A new edition of the Sun Tran Ride Guide is now available offering passengers detailed route and service changes effective August 12 through November 10, 2007.

- Sun Tran will launch later weeknight service on six more routes funded by the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA). Routes 2, 21, 23, 26, 27 and 29 will receive weeknight service until 11 p.m.
- Routes 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 11 will receive extended weekend service hours also funded by the RTA.
- Route 16 will have service on Ina Road and extended hours on Sundays.
- To improve on-time performance, the Route 1 weekday and weekend schedules will change.
- The downtown portion of the Route 9 has changed to improve on-time performance.
- To accommodate the downtown road improvement projects, Routes 9, 19, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27, 29, 34 and 50 will experience schedule changes.

The Sun Tran Ride Guide is available on buses and at over 500 locations, such as public libraries, major malls, transit centers, pass sales and information outlets throughout Tucson, and at Sun Tran's administrative office, located at 4220 South Park Avenue.
