TUCSON, Ariz. – Sun Tran and KGUN 9 News are partnering to promote a summer “Stuff-the-Bus” food drive benefitting the Tucson Community Food Bank. On Friday, June 29, a Sun Tran coach will be located at Sam Levitz Furniture’s eastside location at 100 North Pantano Road. Donations will be accepted from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m.
