## Sun Tran's Christmas Day Schedule:

- The information booth at Ronstadt Transit Center will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Laos and Tohono Tadaí Transit Centers will be closed. All three transit centers will re-open for business on Wednesday, December 26, from 6:00 a.m. until 6:15 p.m.
- Buses will continue to serve all three transit centers.
