RIDE SUN TRAN'S UA FOOTBALL SHUTTLE Hi Corbett & Tucson Mall boarding locations change this week

TUCSON, Ariz. – Hop on Sun Tran's UA Football Shuttle and arrive relaxed and ready to cheer the Wildcats to victory. This week passengers can park for free and ride from:

- El Pueblo Neighborhood Center located at 101 West Irvington Road, which is the southwest corner of Irvington Road at Sixth Avenue/Nogales Highway.

The following boarding locations have changed for this week's game due to various community events:

- Tucson Mall – Passengers can park and board in the lot on the southeast corner of the mall near Stone and Wetmore.
- Hi Corbett Field – This week only, passengers can park and board the shuttle from two locations. Park near Building 900 on Randolph Way just north of the Reid Park Zoo entrance. Passengers can also park in the lot at the SW corner of Reid Park off 22nd Street. Use the Lakeshore Drive entrance to the park that is just west of Randolph Way. Signs will be posted.

Round-trip full-fare is \$2. Round-trip half-fares are \$1 for seniors 65 years of age or older, persons with disabilities, and Medicare cardholders. Children 5 years-old and under ride free.

Shuttles begin departing for the stadium two hours before game time and run continuously until kick-off. Passengers arrive in front of Arizona Stadium on 6th Street, just steps from the entrance. Riders may begin boarding on 6th Street at the beginning of the fourth quarter to return to their original pick-up location. Buses will run for approximately one hour after the game ends.
