### **3-DAY TRANSIT PASS FOR WEEKEND EVENTS**

*Sun Link Provides Convenient and Cost-Effective Transit Option for Busy Weekend Schedule*

**TUCSON, Ariz.** –The 3-Day Pass provides unlimited rides on Sun Link for 72 consecutive hours once activated on the streetcar. With a 3-Day Pass, passengers attending some of Tucson’s weekend events can ride the streetcar for convenient, multi-day travel within the districts.

Events include:

- Tucson Jazz Festival: Events through Sunday, January 21st in Downtown Tucson
- Dillinger Days: Friday, January 19th and Saturday, January 20th at Hotel Congress
- Arizona Wildcat Hockey Games: Friday, January 19th and Saturday, January 20th, 7:30 PM at Tucson Convention Center
- Zoppé Family Circus: Shows through Sunday, January 21st at Mercado San Agustin

Streetcar passengers can easily purchase a 3-Day Pass before the weekend using the GoTucson Transit mobile app, or visiting a SunGO Sales Outlet or Ticket Vending Machine at one of three transit centers. A 3-Day Pass costs \$10 (\$11 total when loaded on the GoTucson Transit app or \$12 total when including the cost of a new SunGO Card).

Parking is available near all the 23 Sun Link streetcar stops, including free parking at all UA garages on weekends, except 2nd St. Garage. Sun Link also offers late-night service on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights until 2 AM, so passengers can be confident to know they will have a ride back to their car.

The 3-Day Pass is currently being tested in a pilot program to determine if it will become a permanent transit pass product. The six-month trial period for purchasing a 3-Day Pass is set to end February 15, 2018. A 3-Day Pass will still be accepted on transit vehicles after this date, if purchased prior to February 15th.

Riders can also purchase a 1-Day Pass for events occurring within the same 24-hour period since they provide unlimited rides on Sun Link for 24 consecutive hours after first use. Each passenger is required to have a SunGO Card or Ticket, or a pass on the GoTucson Transit App, as cash is not accepted once on the streetcar. Children five years of age and younger can ride Sun Link free with a paying passenger.
