## **SUN TRAN “STUFF-THE-BUS” TO BENEFIT COMMUNITY FOOD BANK**

**TUCSON**, Ariz. – Sun Tran has partnered once again with HSL Properties and KGUN 9 News to sponsor a “Stuff-the-Bus” food drive, benefiting the Community Food Bank of Southern Arizona. On Friday, January 12th, a Sun Tran bus will collect donations at the Canyon Oaks Apartments, at 600 N. Pantano Road (between Broadway and Speedway), from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Community members are asked to bring non-perishable food items and/or monetary donations to the event. Items such as canned soups, boxed cereals, canned fruits and vegetables, peanut butter, and canned meats such as tuna fish, chicken, and corned beef are often in short supply. Please refrain from donating items in glass jars, frozen turkeys, or items that have expired.

“Often after the holidays, the Community Food Bank has used all of its supplies, but many families still need assistance,” said Steve Spade, Interim General Manager for Sun Tran. “So we invite everyone to make a donation, whether big or small, because each item will help local families in need.”

Sun Tran is proud to serve our community and partner with local organizations to make a positive difference in Tucson. Since 2001, more than 230,000 pounds of food and more than \$150,000 in cash donations have been collected for local families.
