TRANSIT SCHEDULE ON INDEPENDENCE DAY

Sun Link to extend service hours on July 4th until conclusion of "A" Mountain fireworks

TUCSON, Ariz. –Transit service for Independence Day on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 is as follows:

- Sun Tran Routes 1 through 99 and the Sun Link streetcar will run on a Sunday schedule.
- Sun Express Routes 101X-204X will not be in operation.
- Sun Shuttle fixed-route service and the Sahuarita/Green Valley Sun Shuttle Dial-a-Ride will not be in operation. Sun Shuttle Dial-a-Ride service provided by Discount Cab and Oro Valley Dial-a-Ride will offer service for ADA qualified passengers only from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Sun Van service will mirror the service provided by Sun Tran. Sun Van's Reservation Center will be open 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Independence Day.
- The Customer Service Center will be open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. to assist passengers with trip planning needs. On Thursday, July 5, the Customer Service Center will return to regular weekday hours of 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Special Services Office, located at 35 W. Alameda, will be closed on Wednesday, July 4 and will reopen for business on Thursday, July 5 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- Sun Tran's Administrative Office, located at 3920 N. Sun Tran Blvd., will be closed on Wednesday, July 4 and will reopen for business on Thursday, July 5, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

On Thursday, July 5th, all transit services resume regular service.

Sun Link will extend its hours of operation on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 with the last trip departing about 30 minutes following the conclusion of the "A" Mountain fireworks.

Find FREE, convenient parking along the streetcar route at any of the University of Arizona parking garages on the Fourth of July holiday. The following University of Arizona Garages offer ample parking and easy access to the Sun Link streetcar:

- Tyndall Garage: 4th Street & Tyndall, just south of University
- Main Gate Square Garage: 2nd Street & Euclid, just north of Marriott University Park Hotel
- Second Street Garage: 2nd St. & Mountain just south of Speedway
- Highland Garage: Helen & Vine St. 1 block east of Helen & Mountain

Streetcar passengers are encouraged to plan ahead and purchase a SunGO Ticket, or load a pass or cash value to a new or existing SunGO Card before the 4th of July to avoid lines at the streetcar stop ticket vending machines. A 1-Day SunGO Ticket can be purchased for \$4.50 at any one of the streetcar stops or on the GoTucson Transit mobile app. To pay-by-the-ride, riders can purchase a SunGO Card online at www.suntran.com/sungo or at any sales outlet, and load cash value to ride the streetcar. If paying with cash value on a SunGO Card, the cost is \$1.60. A Single-Boarding fare can also be purchased on the GoTucson Transit app for \$2. Cash is not accepted once on the streetcar. Children five years of age and younger can ride Sun Link free with a paying passenger.
