SUN SHUTTLE SERVICE CHANGES EFFECTIVE MARCH 19

RTA Board approves route and schedule changes

TUCSON, Ariz. – Starting March 19th, new service changes will begin for several Sun Shuttle routes. The RTA Board recently approved the proposed changes to increase efficiency and improve on-time performance. Current schedules and routes, set to expire March 6th, will remain active until the new effective date.

Updated Sun Shuttle brochures are available now at suntran.com/sunshuttle and will be available on the vehicles starting Monday, March 12th. Brochures provide passengers current fare information and detailed route schedules. The new schedule information will be effective through August 4, 2018.

Specific routes and scheduling changes include:

Oro Valley

- Route 401 has discontinued Saturday service due to low ridership over many years. Travel will be redirected along Oracle Rd., no longer serving stops on W. Magee Rd. and CDO High School.

Marana

- Route 410 has discontinued Saturday service, due to low ridership over many years, and adjusted weekday schedule.
- Route 411 service has been discontinued due to low ridership over many years.
- Route 412 has added a new stop to serve the Tucson Premium Outlets and adjusted weekday and weekend schedules. Travel will be redirected west on Linda Vista Blvd. to serve the Tucson Premium Outlets, and will no longer service stops on Tangerine Rd. and Thornydale Rd.
- Route 413 has added a new stop to serve the Tucson Premium Outlets and adjusted weekday and weekend schedules.

Green Valley and Sahuarita

- Route 421 has discontinued Saturday service, due to low ridership over many years. Travel will be redirected along La Cañada Drive, between Duval Mine Road south to Trader Lane, and will add a new stop to serve Green Valley Village. Route 421 will no longer serve stops at Posada Life Community Center on Continental Road

Tucson Estates

- Route 430 has discontinued Saturday service due to low ridership over many years.

San Xavier

- Route 440 weekday schedules have been adjusted to improve on-time performance.

Southeast Tucson / Rita Ranch

- Route 450 travel will be rerouted along Houghton Road, between Seven Generations Way and Bilby Road, no longer traveling through Civano and Sierra Morado. Route 450 weekday schedules have been adjusted.

Sun Shuttle is the region's neighborhood transit service funded by the Regional Transportation Authority, serving Marana, Oro Valley, Catalina, Sahuarita, Green Valley, San Xavier and Tucson Estates.

The Regional Transportation Authority is the fiscal manager of the \$2.1 billion plan approved by Pima County voters on May 16, 2006. The RTA Board is comprised of representatives from the local jurisdictions in Pima County, including the cities of Tucson and South Tucson, Pima County, the towns of Marana, Oro Valley and Sahuarita, the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation.
