SUN LINK PREPARES TO CELEBRATE FOUR MILLION PASSENGERS

On-board performance planned to commemorate ridership milestone

TUCSON, Ariz. –Sun Link is expected to reach four million passengers on Thursday, September 20th. In celebration of the milestone benchmark, the four-millionth passenger will receive special gifts and recognition when they come on board the streetcar.

Sun Link will also celebrate with a live performance on-board the streetcar by The Endless Pursuit, at approximately 5:00 p.m. Riders can board at the Main Gate Square stop on University Blvd. and Tyndall Ave. to watch the band play.
