SUMMERGO YOUTH PASS PROGRAM RETURNS MAY THROUGH AUGUST

Unlimited rides on regional public transit throughout summer for kids ages 6 to 18, plus discounts to activities

TUCSON, Ariz. – Sun Tran will bring the SummerGO Youth Pass program back for its fourth year. The SummerGO Youth Pass provides youth ages 6 to 18 unlimited rides on Sun Link, Sun Tran and select Sun Shuttle routes from May 25 through August 2 for \$45.

Youth can use the SummerGO Youth Pass and get free entrance to all City of Tucson pools (open May 31-August 1), except Edith Ball Adaptive Recreation Center.

Pass holders can also buy one admission to the Flandrau Science Center and Planetarium, on the University of Arizona campus, and get another admission of equal or lesser value free with a SummerGO Pass.
