PERFORMANCE ON SUN LINK TO CELEBRATE TUCSON FOLK FESTIVAL

TUCSON, Ariz. – The Tucson Folk Festival continues on the Sun Link streetcar! On Saturday, April 6th at 6:00 p.m., passengers can catch a special performance onboard the streetcar by Folk Festival artist, Alec Lytle & Them Rounders.

The performance will begin from the streetcar stop, at Broadway Blvd/6th Ave., and travel eastbound towards Helen St/Warren Ave. The streetcar will then travel back westbound to the Congress St/6th Ave. station, where festival goers can return to the event at Jácome Plaza.

Alec Lytle & Them Rounders originate from Northern California and play original Americana influenced songs that are rich in creative storytelling.

The Tucson Folk Festival takes place Saturday, April 6th and Sunday, April 7th. The streetcar will operate on Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

To ride the streetcar, all passengers are required to have a valid fare. Load a pass or add stored value to a SunGO Card, SunGO Ticket, or on the GoTucson Transit app.

A SunGO pass or ticket can be purchased at any one of the Sun Link streetcar stops, a transit center ticket vending machine, from a sales outlet, or on the GoTucson Transit app.

Cash fares are not accepted once on the streetcar. Children ages 5 and under ride free with a paying passenger.
