## **NEW SCHEDULES FOR SUN TRAN'S EXPRESS ROUTES**

*Service changes effective Monday, May 20th*

**TUCSON**, Ariz. – On Monday, May 20th, new service changes will begin for Sun Express routes. All Sun Tran Express passengers should check the details of their individual schedules as many routes have been updated. Notable service changes include:

- **Routes 101X, 103X, 105X, 109X and 110X have adjusted weekday schedules.**
- **Routes 102X, 103X, 104X, 203X and 204X are redirected to travel along Ina Rd.**

Sun Express is a fast commuter transportation service that makes limited stops, from outlying areas to major destinations, Monday through Friday during peak commuting hours. Sun Express includes 12 routes that serve the following areas:

- **Route 101X – Golf Links - Downtown**
- **Route 102X – Northwest - University of Arizona**
- **Route 103X – Northwest - Downtown**
- **Route 104X – Marana - Downtown**
- **Route 105X – Foothills - Downtown**
- **Route 107X – Oro Valley - Downtown**
- **Route 108X – Broadway - Downtown**
- **Route 109X – Catalina Highway - Downtown**
- **Route 110X – Rita Ranch - Downtown**
- **Route 201X – Eastside - Aero Park**
- **Route 203X – Oro Valley - Aero Park**
- **Route 204X – Marana - Aero Park**

Passengers can find updated schedules and route information online and in the Sun Express Route Booklet, located on transit vehicles and at various locations throughout Tucson.

Current Sun Express schedules and routes are set to expire May 19th.

All regular Sun Tran routes and schedules will remain the same.
