Sun Van is Tucson's paratransit service, operating in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 to serve individuals who, due to a disability, are unable to ride Sun Tran. Its active fleet consists of 139 ADA-accessible cutaway vans. In

Introduced in 2020, Sun On Demand offers shared, curb-to-curb rides within designated zones. Riders are picked up and dropped off at the curb in front of their start and destination addresses. The service also connects riders to other modes of transportation, enhancing mobility options. Sun On Demand operates with a fleet of six ADA-accessible cutaway vans.
